Report on Student's Satisfaction Survey, 2020-21

Objectives of Student Survey:

This survey has three main objectives:

1. To provide students with the opportunity to comment on the quality of their learning experiences.
2. To assess the success of education and learning provisions in relation to the expectations of students.
3. To provide feedback to teachers and management in order to improve delivery and content of the study unit and programme.

Methodology:

The survey asks questions that will provide information about implementation support. Enhance knowledge and changed practice. The sample size of the study is 200 wherein 170 students of B.A. 1st semester and 30 students are from B.A. 3rd semester.

Analysis and Interpretation:

- Out of the total respondents, 80% of the students are of the view that the teachers have covered 85% to 100% of the course in the class.
- Around 80% students have shown satisfaction towards the behavior of the teachers and supporting staff of the college.
- 50% of the students have shown dissatisfaction on the use of library resource.
- Maximum numbers of students have shown only satisfaction regarding the cleanliness and food items provided in the college canteen.
